The quilts you will see hanging on the pews this weekend were made by the Mount Olive quilters to be sent to Lutheran World Relief along with fabric kits and hygiene kits. LWR sends these items all over the world – including Florida, North Carolina, and Tennessee after devastating storms hit those states this year. Over 60,400 quilts and 76,300 kits were distributed to neighbors whose homes were damaged or destroyed.
